1. Key points

Our aim is to ensure uniformity across all ages with our school uniform, ensuring every students' attire is neat and presentable at all times; taking pride in being a student of MSB Private School.

There is an expectation that students will comply with the dress requirements and parents' cooperation is sought to ensure that their child(ren) are wearing an immaculate school uniform at all times.

Students' uniform requirements are outlined below:

- Students must wear MSB-issued uniforms exclusively (which carries the school logo). It should not be bought from any other private supplier.
- Students are required to wear uniform of the appropriate size and length.
- Students must be dressed neatly and wear clean uniforms at all times.
- Students must carry ID cards every day to school.
- P.E. uniform is to be worn on P.E. days only.
- Students should label/mark initials on all their belongings/shoes. The school holds no responsibility for any lost items.
- Students must only wear school-issued cardigans/blazers (with school logo) during winter.
- The school bag is part of the required uniform for our FS students and will be assigned to every child personally by their Form Tutors. Any other bag will not be accepted.
- Boys must have their hair cut short and should wear the topi.
- Girls must have long hair tied and should wear the school-provided scarves.
- All students must have short and clean nails.
- Girls may not wear nail polish or make-up. Jewellery should not be worn to school, except for girls who can wear stud earrings. Simple watches are permitted for both boys and girls.
- Unless otherwise stated, students will be expected to wear regular school uniform on excursions/trips/events.
- Principal may make exceptions to the Uniform Policy for special events.

2. Disciplinary actions for violations

If students do not adhere to the Uniform Policy outlined above and do not wear the proper uniform, (s)he will be reminded in the first instance to amend this with immediate effect. If this is not possible and if a student further does not comply then the parents will be contacted and (s)he will not be allowed to attend school until they adhere to the school Uniform Policy outlined above.
